


Four Components of Student Success Systems

Research must inform practice, and practice must inform research.

 2. High School Completion Study
- **Purpose of studies:** to better understand the individual and systemic barriers and strengths experienced by the LD community and those who serve them.
- **Unique strategy:**
 - Center the voices of young adults with LD and their teachers in the conceptualization, design, analysis, and dissemination of the research.




